### East Columbus Soccer Development Program

With a grant from the Columbus Recreation and Parks Department's "Youth First Program", the Foundation launched the East Columbus Soccer Development Program (ECSD) last spring. The program helps players from the community develop advanced skills necessary for competitive club or travel teams.

The Foundation partnered with the William H. Adams Community Recreation Center at Krumm Park and the Columbus East Soccer Association (CESA) to implement the program. CESA offers a dedicated soccer program with emphasis on player development, team structure, technical skills and tactical awareness.







Under the direction of Coach Brooks Fields the Adams team took 2nd place in the spring recreational league at Easton Park. The program has grown in popularity with many more players coming out for the fall season.
